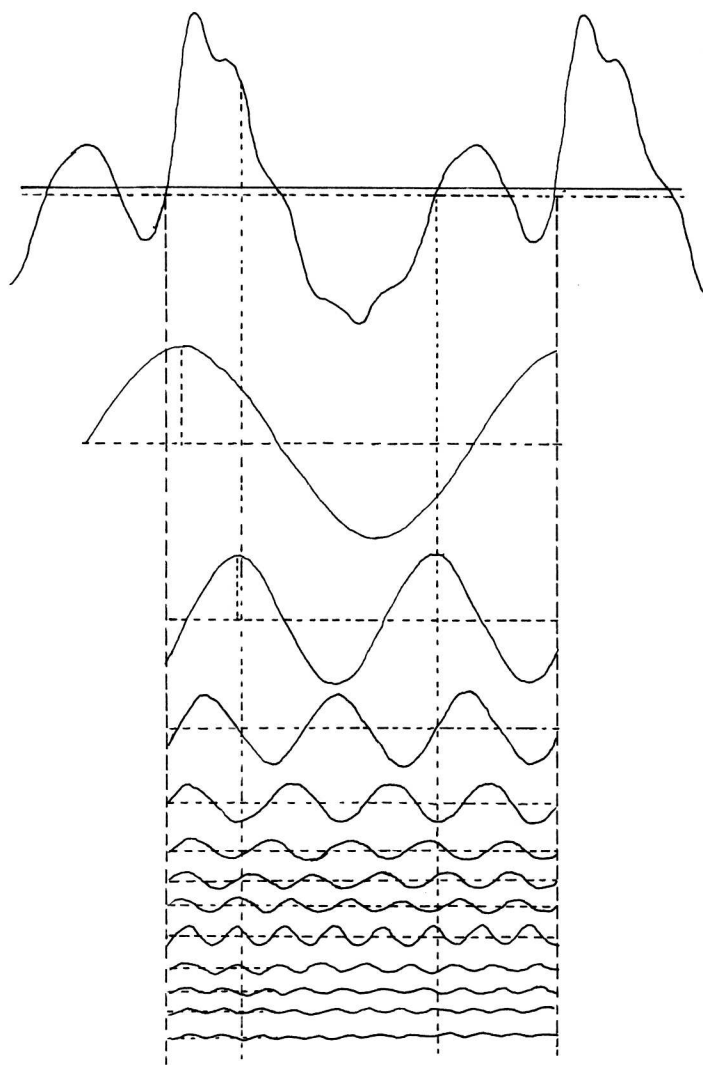
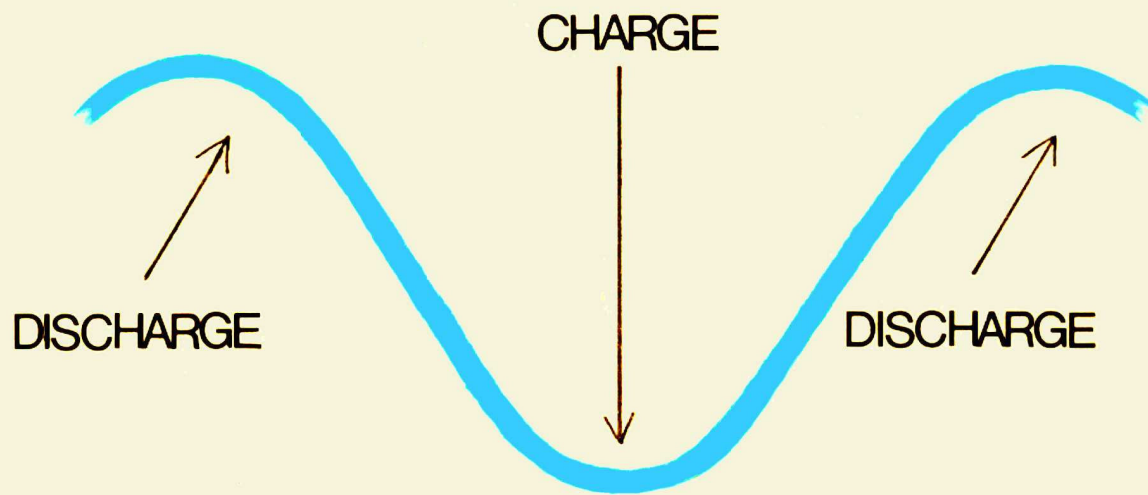
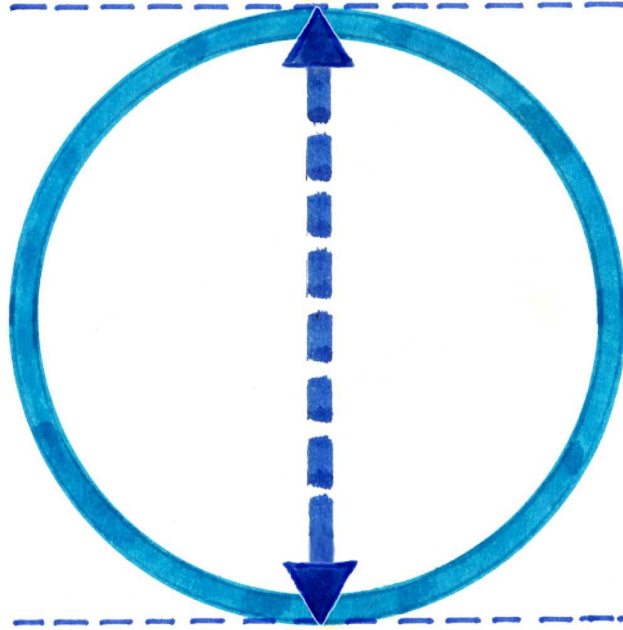


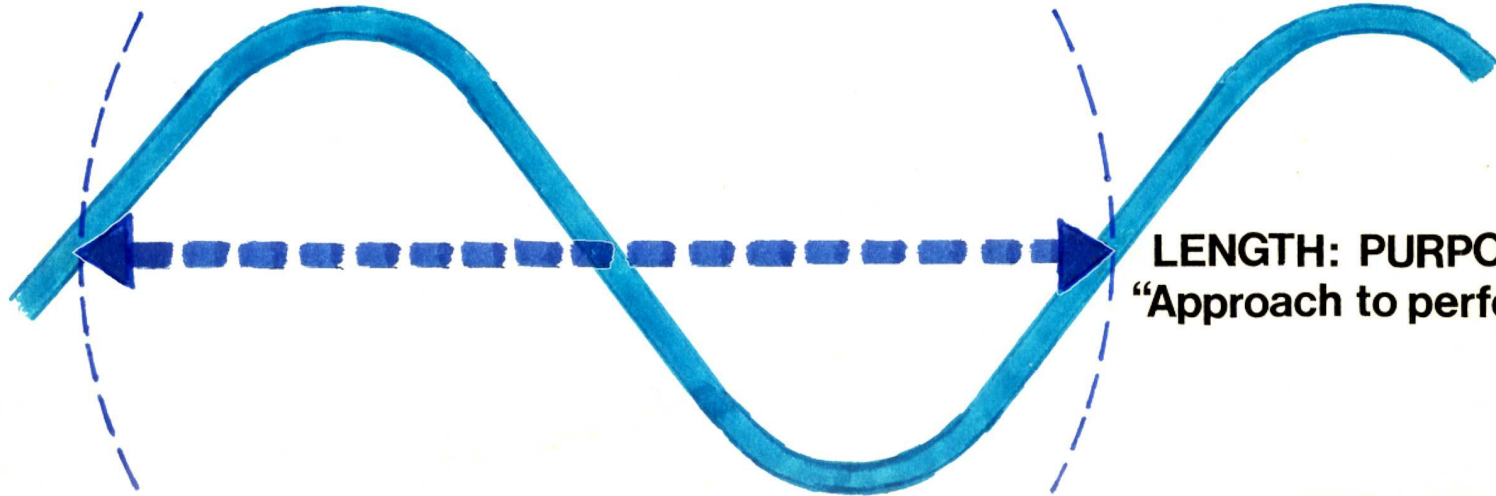
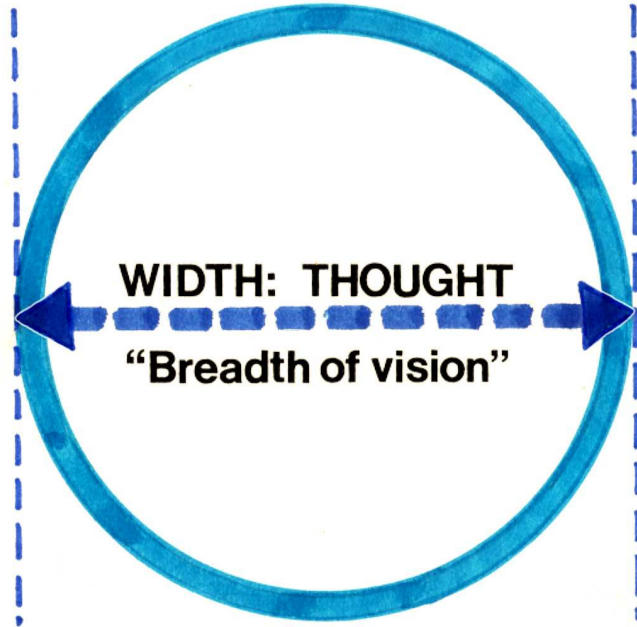
Fig. 24. An Organ pipe curve (top) and its first twelve harmonic components.



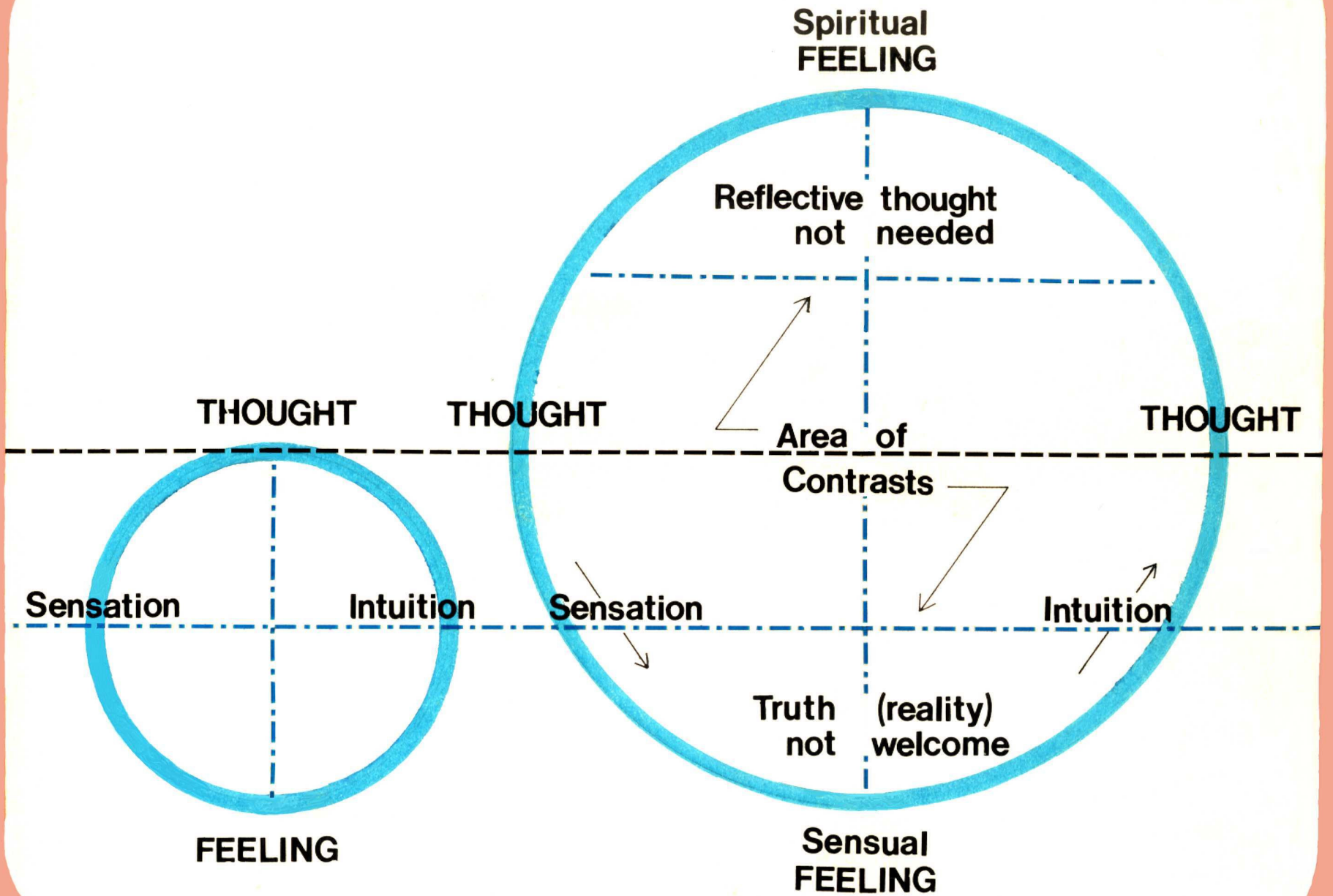

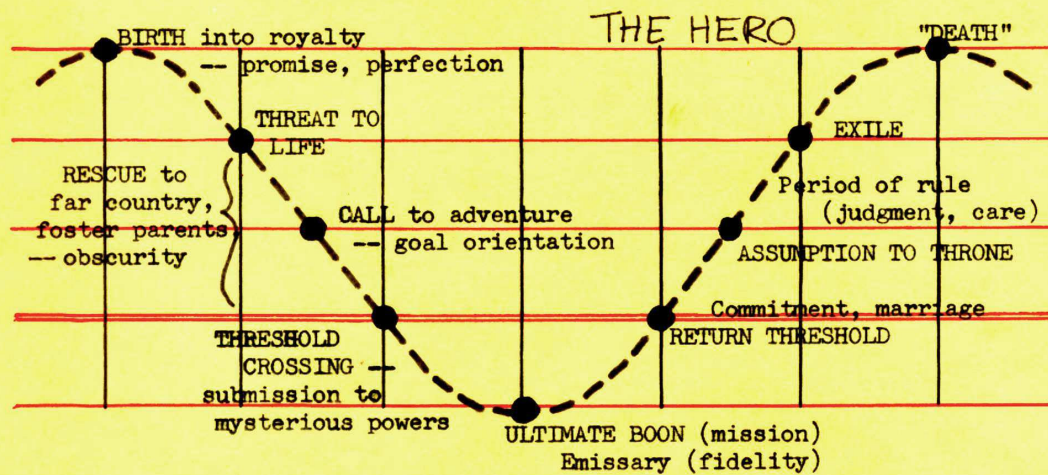
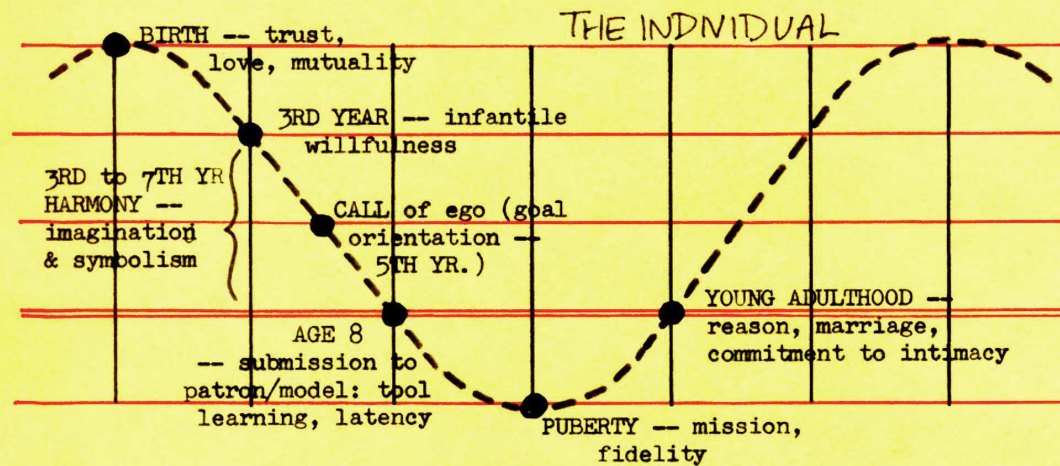
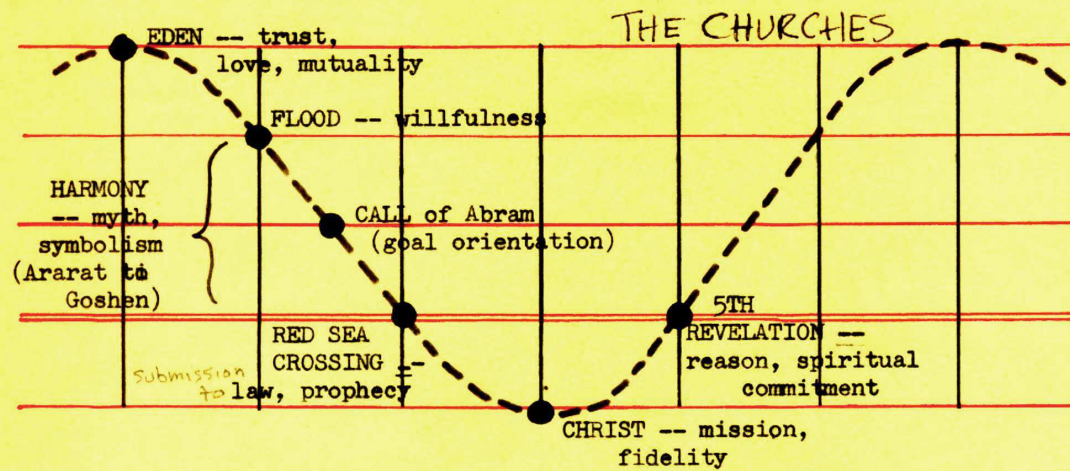
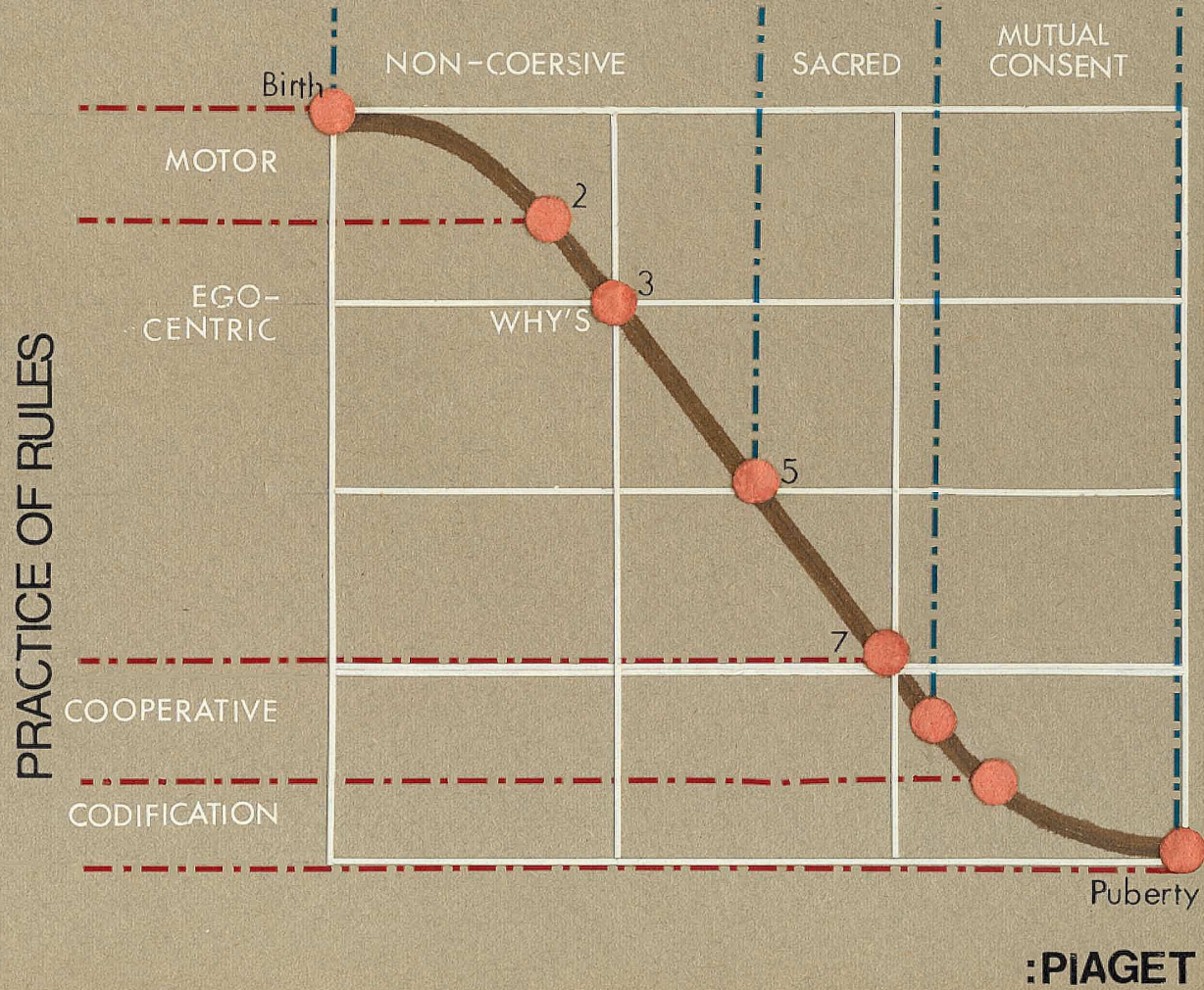


FIG. 15, comparing (top to bottom) cycles of revelations, individual growth, & hero. Latter stages will be compared in future chapters.

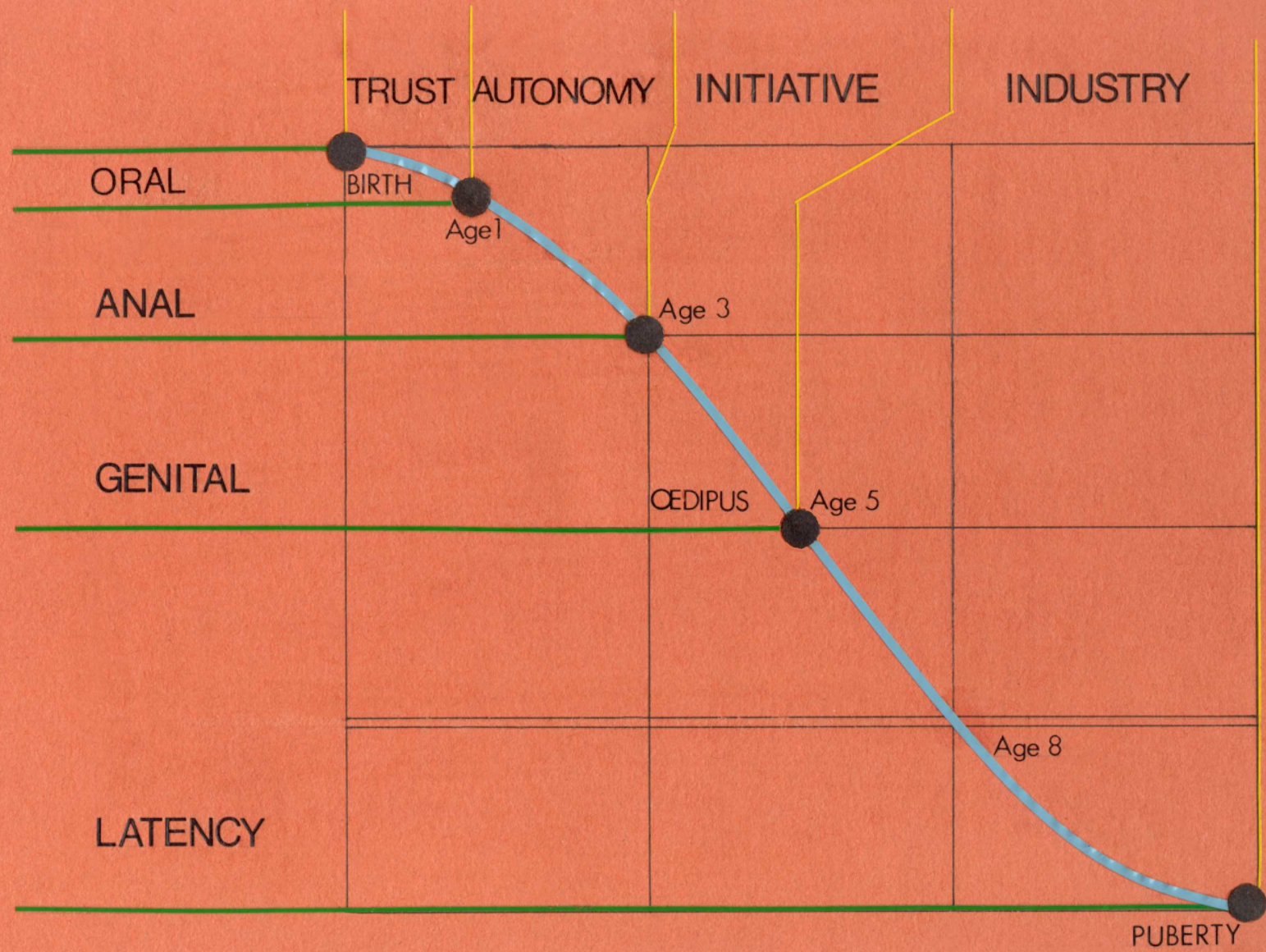

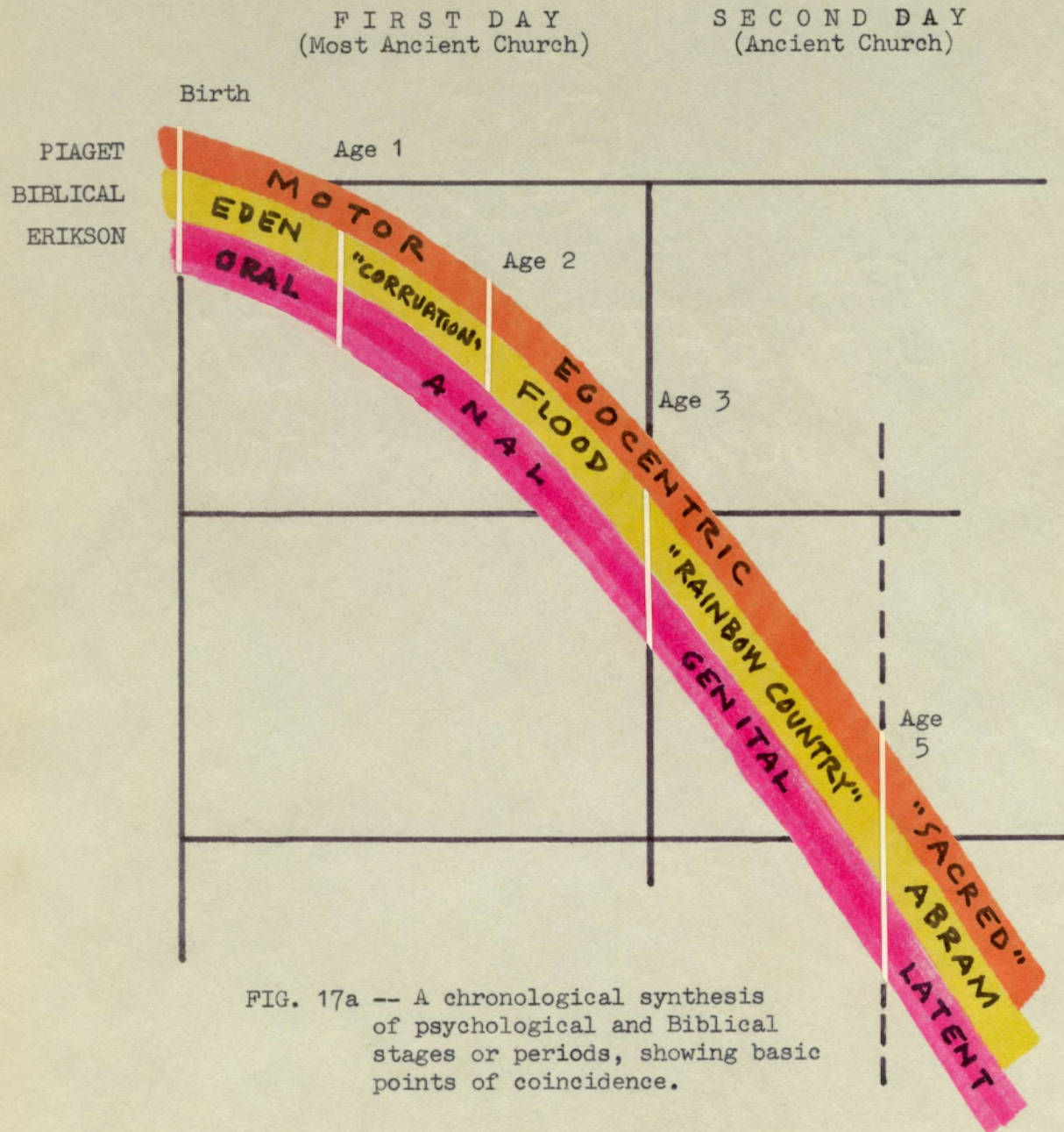


FIG. 17a -- A chronological synthesis of psychological and Biblical stages or periods, showing basic points of coincidence.

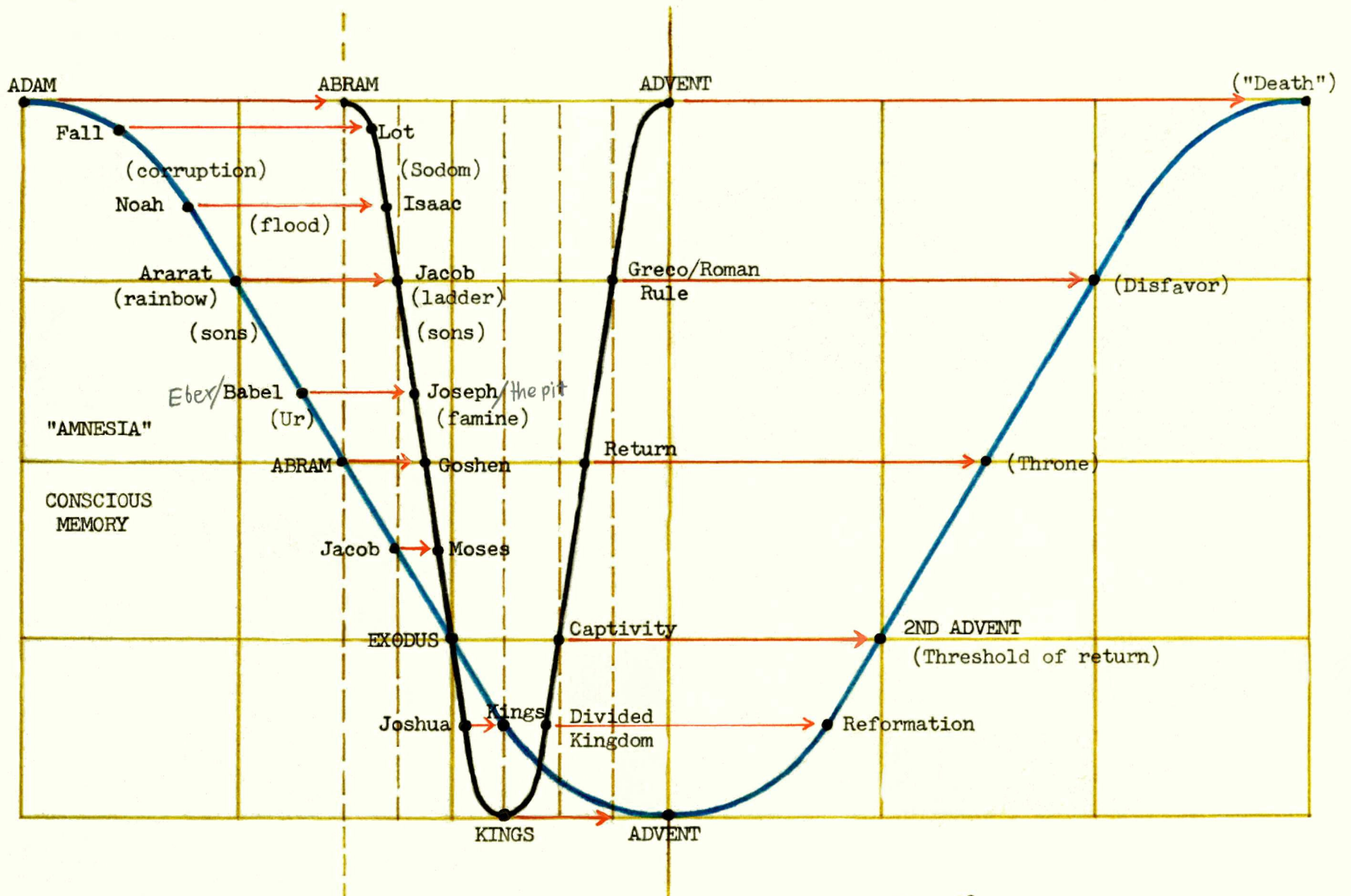
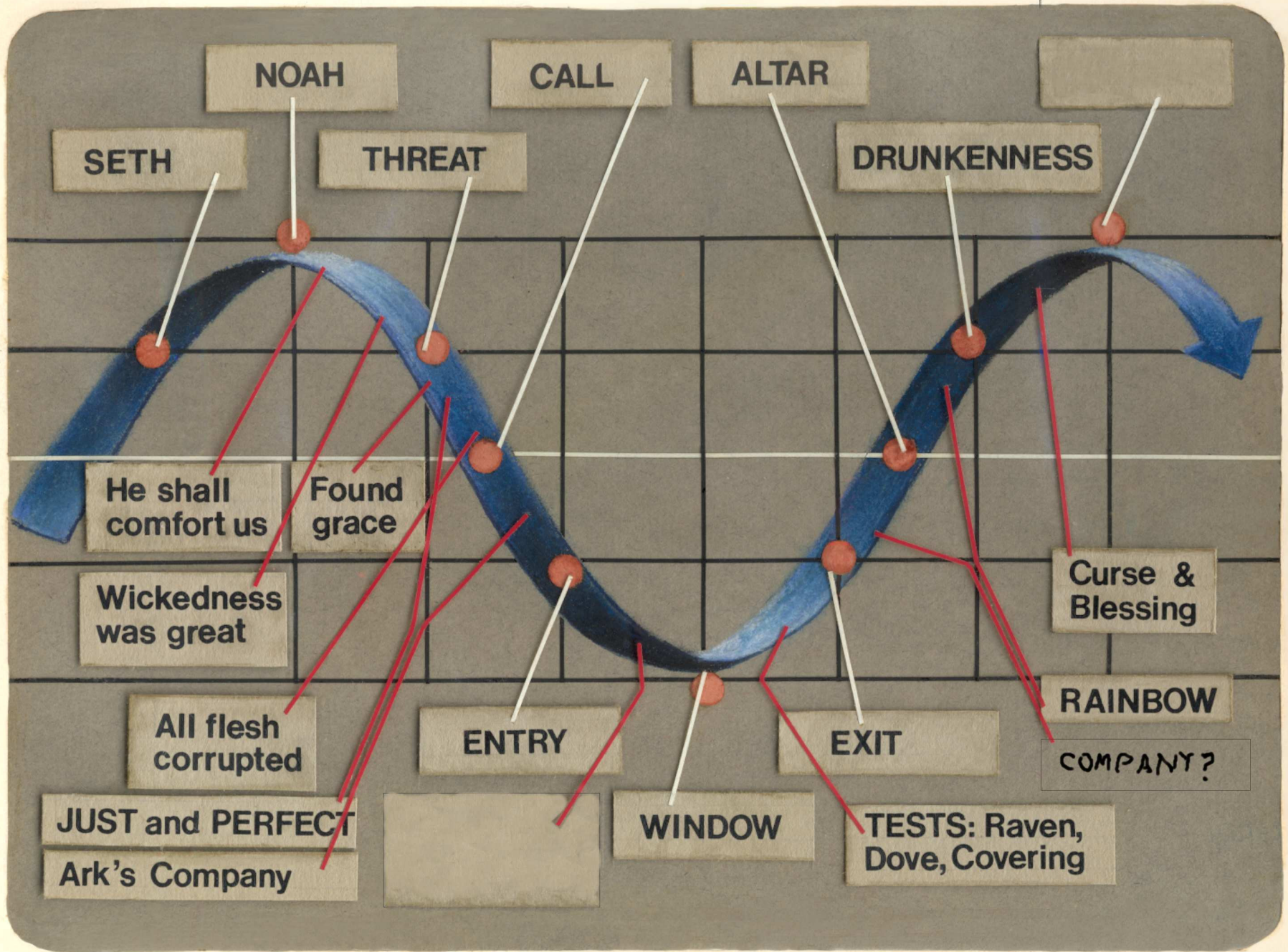
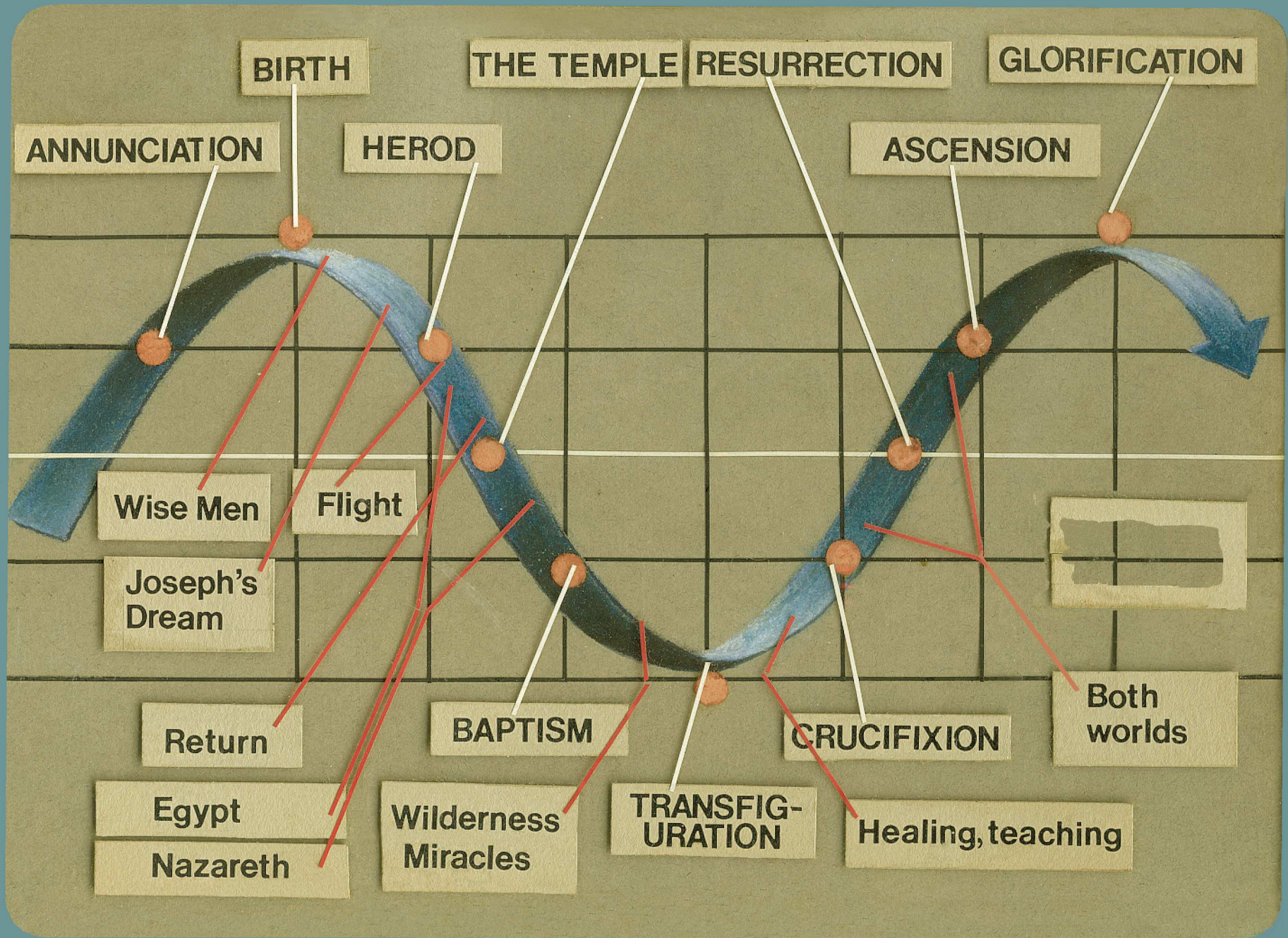
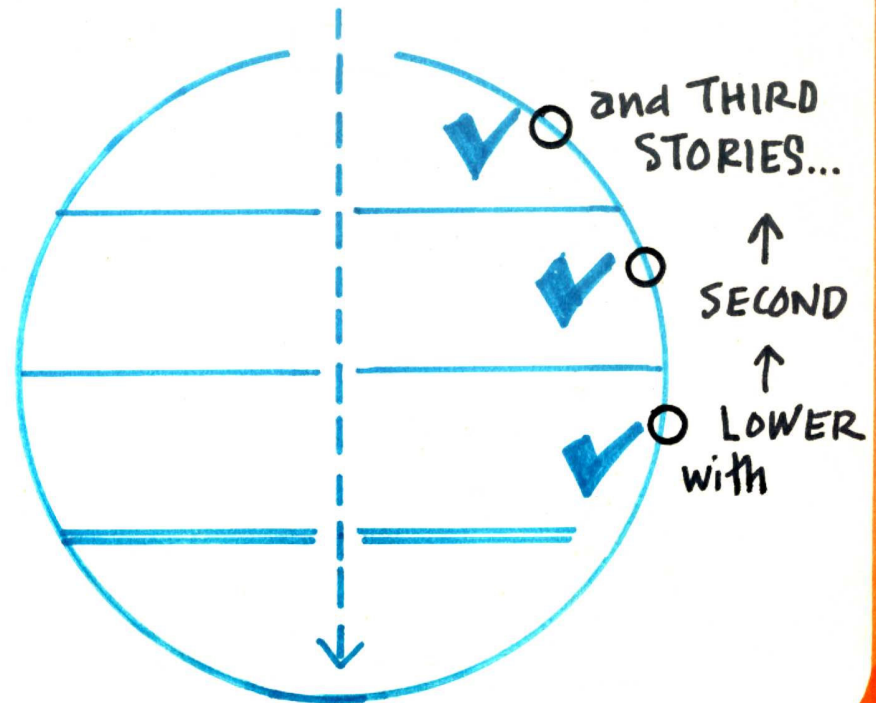
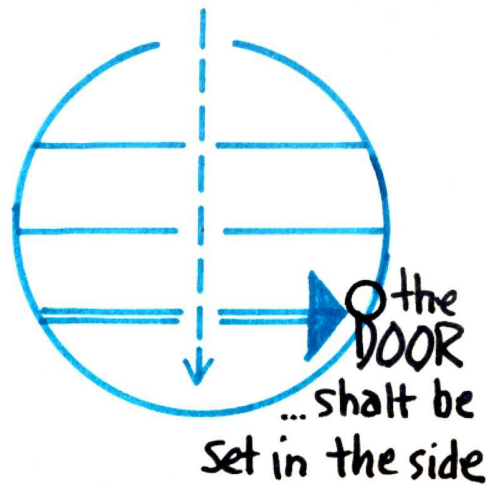
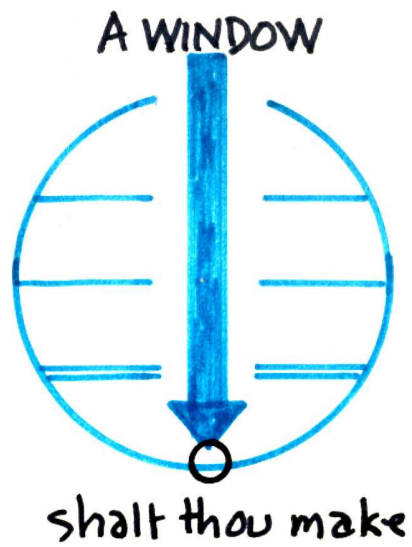
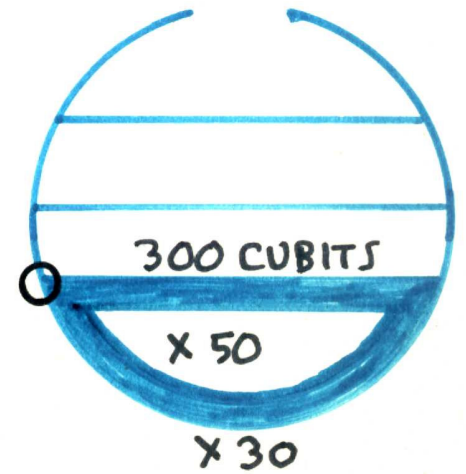
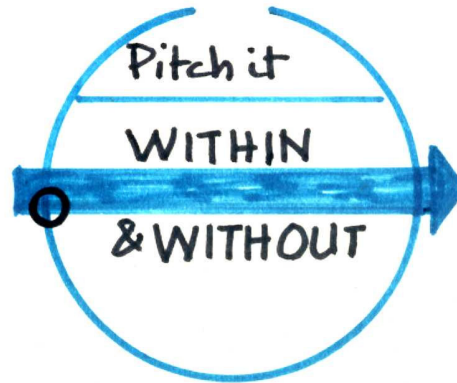
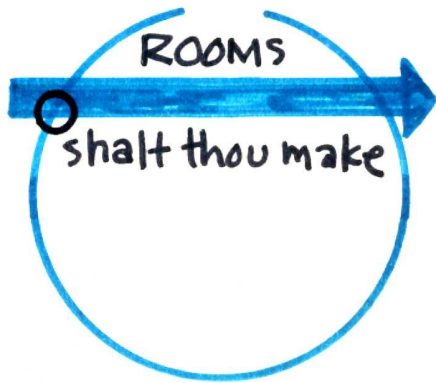

ARIES Ram -- the creative impulse at moment of inception. Undifferentiated. Whole. Original cause. Related to shepherd.

PISCES Fish -- new beginning contained within failure or dissolution (Aquarius); the denial of self and its passions.

TAURUS Bull -- myth of fecundation as victory and sacrifice (Mithras). Division: Yang & Yin, masculine & feminine. Voice, throat.

AQUARIUS Water Bearer -- liberation through destruction; return to oneness (Pisces); the flood; end of formal universe.

GEMINI Twins -- two tendencies, white & black. Creative force severed; half elevated, half descending into multiplicity. Inter-linking of earth and heaven.

CAPRICORN Goat -- mountain (goat) plus abyss (fish); involutive & evolutive potentials; return or depart from the "wheel of rebirth."

CANCER Crab -- threshold of entry or incarnation; phenomena.

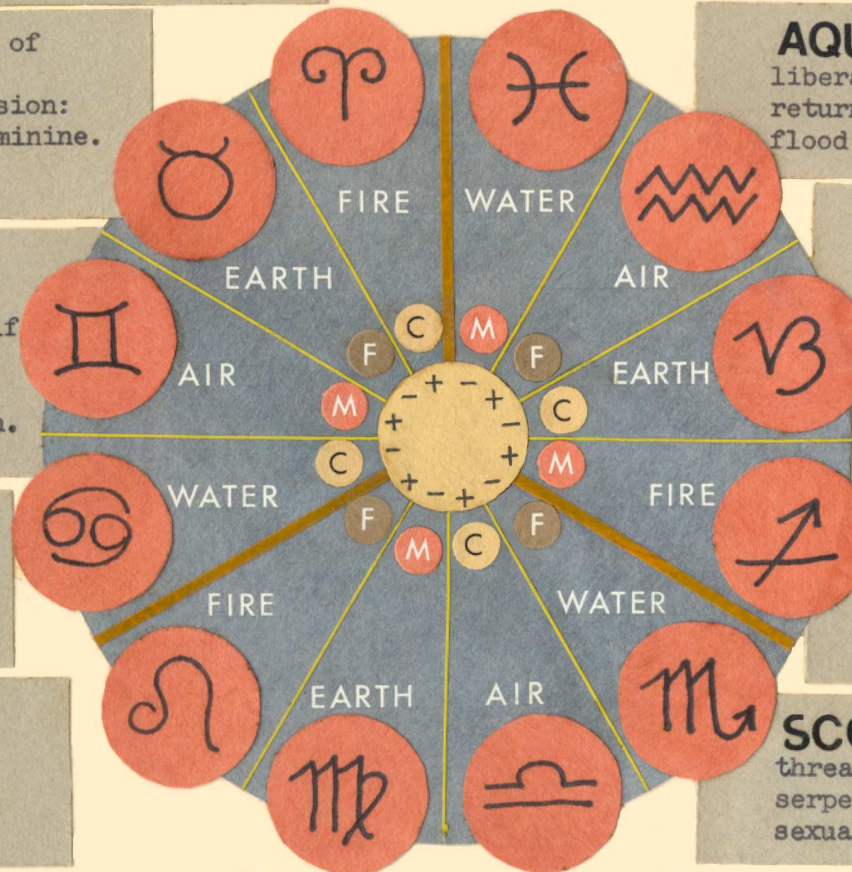
SAGGITARIUS Archer -- animal & spirit; horse plus three higher planes. Bow follows threat (Scorpio). State of linkage or tension.

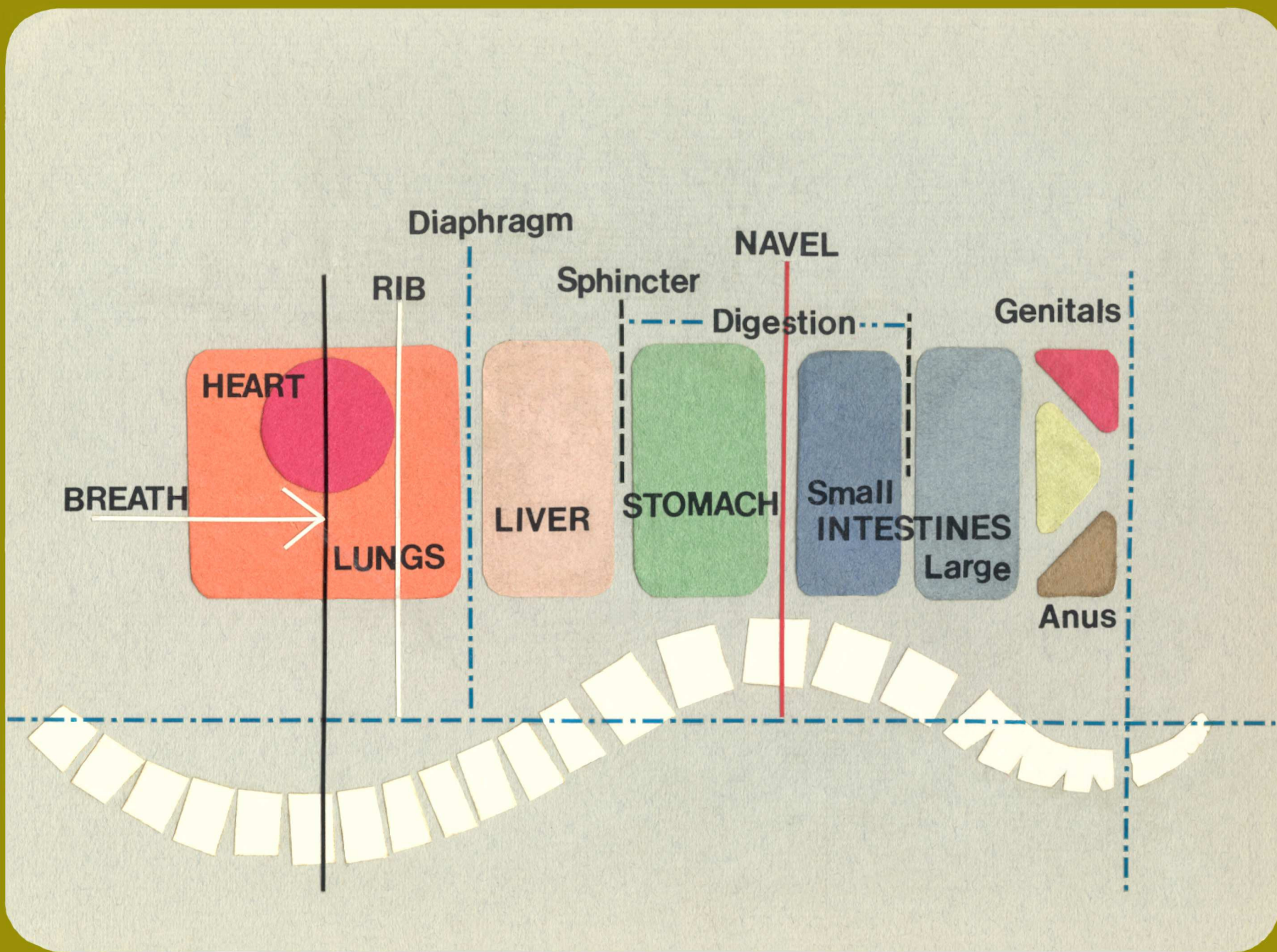
LEO Lion -- solar power, will; the clear, penetrating light that passes through the threshold.

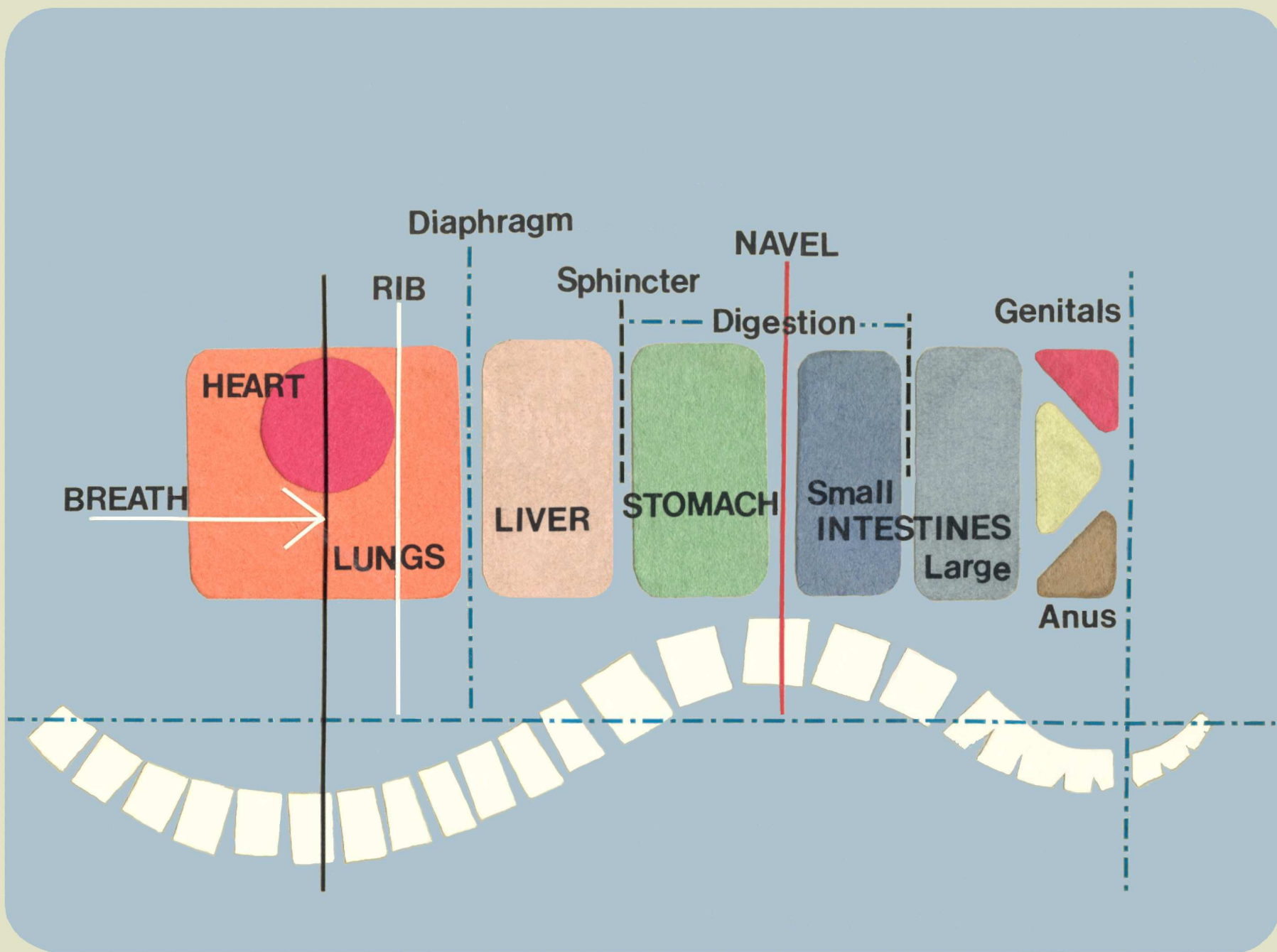
SCORPIO Scorpion -- threat of death, the fall; serpent or eagle; functioning sexuality.

VIRGO Virgin -- always associated with birth of a god or demigod; governed by Mercury (Hermes, Spermatikos); supreme expression of dynamic consciousness.

LIBRA Scales -- related to sword & cross; equilibrium restored between spirit & nature, good & evil, left & right, conscious & unconscious. Conjunction. Seventh sign.
